### **We are learning to:**

- Know what a sentence is and that it makes sense on its own.
- Know that a sentence needs a verb (an action word).
- Know that two sentences (clauses) can be joined together to add information.
- Know that sentences (clauses) can be joined in different ways.
- Consistently use full stops and capital letters.
- Make our writing interesting by using adjectives.
- Continuing to practise forming our letters correctly ensuring clear ascenders (t, d, h, k, l) and descenders (q, y, p, j).

### **What you can do to help:**

- Ensure you are reading at least three times a week and making a note in our school reading diary.

## Maths

We will be using concrete apparatus such as Numicon and Base 10 to make and describe numbers. We will then move on to drawing these numbers pictorially.

### **We are learning to:**

- Recognise and understand the value of one digit and two digit numbers (12 = 1 ten and 2 ones).
- Order and compare 2 digit numbers.
- Write numbers to 100 in digits and words.
- Mental recall of addition and subtraction facts up to 10/20 (using our number bond challenge).
- Count in 10's, 5's or 2's forwards and backwards.

### **What you can do to help:**

- Continue to practise counting in 2's, 5's and 10's forwards and backwards.
- Practise describing tens and ones in a two digit number using everyday objects such as money. e.g 12p = 10p + 2p OR 12 p = 10P + 1p + 1p
