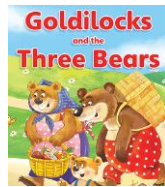
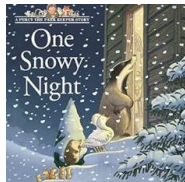


Nursery: Spring 1

Literacy

We are looking at the author Nick Butterworth. If you have a book by the author that we could borrow, please bring it in. We are using 'Talk 4 Writing' to learn Snow Still and Goldilocks and the Three Bears. We will be looking at how different shapes can be used to represent images. E.g a square could be a house.



Maths

We are consolidating our learning on numbers 1, 2, 3 and introducing the numbers 4 and 5 by learning songs. We are learning to recognise, count and subitize.

Children are learning numbers can be represented in different ways. We will also be looking at triangles and squares and developing our mathematical language to describe shapes.



Communication and Language

We are developing our use of 'learning partners' during group time this term. We will be using steps to help us listen and take turns when speaking. We are developing our ability to speak in longer sentences as well as listen and follow instructions.

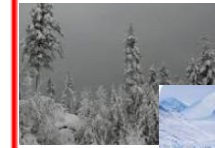
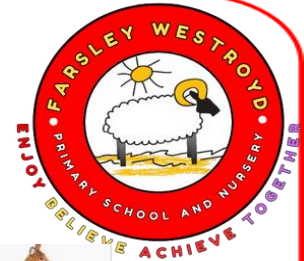
Personal, Social and Emotional Development
