This half term, we are mastering column methods and exploring the relationship between parts and wholes in fractions.

We are learning to:

- Use column addition and subtraction for calculations.
- Recall multiplication facts for 2, 4, and 8.
- Solve problems using our times table knowledge.
- Identify parts and wholes in different contexts.
- Order unit fractions by comparing their sizes.
- Calculate the value of specific fractional parts.
