

Nursery: Summer 2

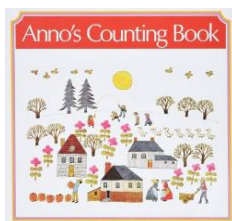
Literacy



We are looking at the author Lucy Cousins. If you have a book by this author that we could borrow please bring it in. We are using 'Talk 4 Writing' to learn 'The Train Ride'. Children starting school in September will take part in simple phonics sessions and continue to practice writing their name. We have mystery readers again in Week 4, if you would like to bring a book in about being healthy please let us know.

Maths

We will be focusing on numbers 1-5 ensuring children have a good understanding of the sequence of these numbers. We will be counting forwards and backwards and ordering numbers. We will also be using lots of songs, stories and rhymes. We are also looking at AB patterns, and matching, sorting and comparing objects.



Communication and Language

Children are focusing on 'why' questions. We will be using questions in story sessions to build children's understanding and developing articulate responses. We are continuing to develop talking using 'learning partners' during group times.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be talking about moving on and starting school. We will be focusing on developing friendships and having group times with those going to the same school as us, as well as those children who will be staying in Nursery. We will be talking about our feelings and emotions linked to moving on and how to express these, especially the opportunity to discuss any worries. We will also be learning pants are private

This half term we are practicing all the skills we have been learning over the course of the year during our daily gross motor sessions. We will also take part in Be Healthy Week activities this half term.
