The My Health, My School Survey 2025/26

Dear parent/carer,

At Farsley Westroyd we believe that pupil voice plays a vital role in shaping our personal development, PSHE and SMSC provision across the curriculum. One of the ways we gather that vital insight is through the **My Health, My School Survey**, an annual initiative commissioned by **Leeds City Council and partners**. The survey gathers valuable insights into the health and wellbeing of children and young people across Leeds, and the results directly inform how we plan and develop our curriculum. During the week beginning **Monday 15th June**, your child's class will be taking part.

Topics covered include:

- Physical activity
- Emotional wellbeing
- Diet and nutrition
- Healthy lifestyles

The information collected helps schools, local authorities, and health services to plan and improve support for young people.

Why We Need Your Consent

In line with the **UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR)** and our **Information Sharing Agreement (ISA)** with Leeds City Council, we must obtain **your explicit consent** before your child can participate in the survey.

- Pupils aged **13 and over** can provide their own consent.
- Participation is **voluntary**, and pupils will be given the choice to take part once consent is received.

How the Survey Works

The survey will be completed by pupils in class on individual computers and supported by a member of school staff who can answer any questions they may have.

Key Information

- The survey is **confidential and anonymous** — your child will not be asked for their name, date of birth, or address at any point.
- Pupils can **withdraw at any time**, including during the survey. If they do, their data will be deleted.
- The survey is completed **online during school hours** and takes approximately **30 minutes** for most year groups (around **10 minutes** for Years 3 and 4).
- Data collected will be used **only for research and planning**. No individual child will be identifiable in any published results.

How Will the Results Be Used?

Individual school results can be used by the school, the School Nursing Service, and Leeds City Council. The survey data may also be shared with organisations such as the University of Leeds and Leeds Beckett University. Local

authority-wide data (an average across all schools) may be shared between these organisations and does not link any individual school to the data.

Will My Child's Survey Results Be Secure?

We will comply fully with all data protection legislation. This means we will keep your child's data safe and secure, now and in the future.

What You Need to Do

Please complete and return the **attached consent form or the paper copy sent home** by **Wednesday 10th June**. If we do not receive your consent, your child will **not** be able to take part in the survey.
