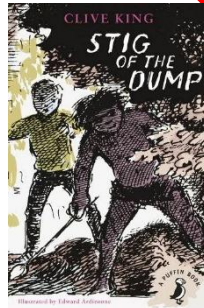


English

Writing:

This half-term, we will be writing 2 of our own independent pieces:

- A diary entry retelling the story of The First Drawing
